





INTRODUCTION

The following photographs are of common insects associated with local prairies and ponds of Madison County, Illinois. All photographs are of insects found in local habitats. In particular, the Heartland Prairie in Alton, IL, The Nature Institute Sanctuary and Preserve in Godfrey, IL, Lewis and Clark Community College campus, also in Godfrey, and the Riverlands Migratory Bird Sanctuary in West Alton, MO, were major sites for photographing the images included in this guide. Although many insects appear in the spring, there are those that appear only during late summer and fall along with numerous species of Goldenrod and Aster that bloom during that period. This guide will cover the more common insect orders found locally and although it presents a good representation of local species it does not represent all species occurring in the varied habitats found in the study area. For those individuals interested in more natural history information on the species included here, there are numerous resources available including field guides and internet sites, especially USDA websites and those supported by state departments of agriculture and natural history and state universities and colleges with programs in entomology, insect pest control, agriculture and horticulture. Over 1,000 species are included in this guide.






